## AUCTION RULES

<b>Administration</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The auction consignments will be exclusive to <b><u>EXHIBITORS ONLY!</u></b></li><li>2. Boxes will be sold so much per bird or animal times the number in the box.</li><li>3. *Boxes will be Limited*</li><li>4. Commission will be 15%.</li><li>5. If the box is required to be resold after the original purchase, the seller will be paid the final sale price.</li><li>6. All buyers should inspect any bird or animal purchased prior to leaving the auction site. No refunds will be made after leaving the auction site.</li><li>7. Any person paying for purchases by cheque with insufficient funds to cover it (NSF) will be denied cheque writing privileges at future auctions.</li><li>8. No postdated cheque will be accepted.</li></ol>
<b>Birds &amp;/or Animals</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. All birds consigned must be a minimum of 3 months old.</li><li>2. All birds and animals must be healthy and in good condition or they will be rejected.</li><li>3. Any birds determined to be crossbred will be rejected.</li></ol>
<b>Boxes</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. No more than 3 birds or animals per box. The only exemptions will be pigeons, doves or quail, which will be a maximum of 5 per box.</li><li>2. Any box with more than the maximum number of birds or animals allowed will be sold as if they contained only the maximum allowed.</li><li>3. All boxes will be inspected before being entered in the sale.</li><li>4. All cardboard boxes must be in good condition and of adequate size with a proper viewing window or they will be rejected. Wire only cages will be rejected.</li><li>5. No wire on top of the box as this can cut up the bird's heads.</li><li>6. All boxes must contain proper bedding such as hay, straw, or wood shavings for the birds or they will be rejected.</li><li>7. Bottoms must be reinforced for larger birds. Plywood bottoms are a must for turkeys, large ducks and geese.</li><li>8. Large rabbits must be in wooden boxes only.</li><li>9. No birds will be accepted in sacks.</li><li>10. The consigner will be asked to help move his boxes through the ring if they are excessively large.</li><li>11. All birds must be sold in the boxes they come in. No re-crating after being sold.</li></ol>
