

E.A.R.S. Show Rules

- ⇒ All entry fees must be paid in full before the commencement of the show. No refunds for scratched rabbits.
- ⇒ Sign in for the show is mandatory prior to judging starting. Please arrive 1 hour prior to judging.
- ⇒ Day of show entries are subject to a \$5 entry fee paid before commencement of the show. No exceptions.
- ⇒ All entries must be in the owner's name and not in the Rabbitry name as per ARBA rules.
- ⇒ Judging will start at 9am Saturday Feb. 13 and Sunday Feb. 14
- ⇒ Entries must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor. Entry forms must state proper name of breed, colour/variety, class, sex and tattoo # of each animal. Incomplete or illegible entry forms will not be accepted. Please read entry form carefully.
- ⇒ All rabbits must be permanently and legibly tattooed in the left ear. **Marker/pen is not acceptable.** Rabbits deemed not to have a legible/permanent tattoo will be disqualified.
- ⇒ All **substitutions must be presented to the Show Secretary** and will be allowed until 8:30 am the morning of the show for a \$1 fee per rabbit. The **substitution MUST be the same breed/sex/age with the tattoo being the only variation in the entry.**
- ⇒ No exhibitor shall alter class sheets in any way. Any **changes to the class sheets made by anyone but the Show Secretary or approved committee will be considered void/disqualified, and not eligible for awards or points.**
- ⇒ All exhibitors are responsible for getting their animals to and from the show table before judging of class begins. If you are leaving the judging area, you must make arrangements to have appropriate rabbits taken to the judging table or you forfeit your entry in that class.
- ⇒ **Only Judges, Show Superintendent, Show Secretary and pre- assigned clerks are allowed behind the judging table at any time.**
- ⇒ E.A.R.S. Show Superintendent/Show Committee reserves the right to reject any rabbits suffering from disease or displayed in an unfit or in unclean condition.
- ⇒ All animals are subject to a health inspection prior to being judged. Animals not adhering to health standards outlined by Show Superintendent/Show committee must be removed from the building.
- ⇒ Prizes will not be mailed out if you are not present to accept them.
- ⇒ Exhibitors are encouraged to bring zip ties or cage locks as an extra precaution. E.A.R.S. and/or Wetaskiwin Drill Hall will not be held responsible for any accident, theft, or vandalism. However, every precaution will be taken to prevent any of these occurrences.
- ⇒ The latest edition of the ARBA Standard of Perfection will be the guide to all breeds.
- ⇒ Exhibitors need not be members of E.A.R.S. or the ARBA to show in sanctioned shows.
- ⇒ The Show Superintendent/Show Committee shall decide on any point not covered in the show rules.
